

Cookies Policy

TCP - TERMINAL DE CONTÊINERES DE PARANAGUÁ S.A, TCP PARTICIPAÇÕES S.A. and/or TCP LOG S.A. and its subsidiaries (“TCP” or “we”) use cookies to give you a better online experience in our websites and online platforms.

Some cookies are necessary to provide essential functionality, in this sense, in order to make full use of TCP website, your computer, tablet or mobile phone will need to accept cookies. You can change your cookies settings at any time, but if you decide to block certain types of Cookies, your access to some resources, areas and/or functionality of our website and online platforms may be limited and/or impaired.

By this policy, we will make you aware of our cookies and purposes and help you to protect your privacy, while at the same time providing you with the best online experience. BY CONTINUING TO USE OUR WEBSITE, YOU ARE AGREEING TO US USING COOKIES IN THE MANNER SET OUT IN THIS COOKIES POLICY SO PLEASE READ IT CAREFULLY.

1. What is a Cookie?

Cookies are small text files containing small amounts of information which are downloaded and may be stored on your computer or device by a website or mobile application, helping the website to recognize your device on a next visit. We use the term “cookies” in this policy to refer to all files that collect and transmit information in this way.

The cookies may collect and transmit information via your browser with a purpose of authenticating or identifying the computer (via e.g. the IP address) or the user, and it cannot collect information from your computer and cannot carry any virus or other damaging files. We use the term “cookies” in this policy to refer to all files that collect and transmit information in this way.

Cookies may be ‘persistent’ cookies or ‘session’ cookies. Cookies that are persistent will be stored within the website and remain on your device even after you close your browser or restart your computer. A session cookie will expire at the end of a session, in other words, when the web browser is closed.

2. Why do we use Cookies?

We use cookies to recognize a device when you visit our websites or online platforms and to track which pages you visit on our website, in order to improve their usability, for example, some cookies remember your preferences so that you do not have to repeatedly make these choices when you visit one of our websites.

We also use cookies to improve the security of the website and to validate authenticated user sessions, therefore, to ensure safety, some of our services can only be provided using cookies. In this case, information that is collected by cookies is not used by TCP to identify you, but information processed by cookies may contain information that could be qualified as personal data. For more information on how we use your personal data, please find our Privacy Policy.

3. Cookies used TCP websites and online platforms.

By accepting the cookies banner or by using TCP website functions, you give your consent to TCP to place and/or read cookies from the website or online platform you are visiting. We use both session and persistent cookies on our website and for different purposes:

I. STRICTLY NECESSARY COOKIES

Functional cookies are essential for the operation of the website or online platform. For example, cookies that allow TCP to identify registered users and ensure they can access the website by login. They are generally defined only in response to actions taken by you, which is equivalent to a service request, such as setting your privacy preferences, logging in or filling out forms. If you opt to disable these cookies, you may not be able to access all of the content of the website.

II. PERFORMANCE COOKIES

Performance cookies help TCP to understand the behavior of our visitors and the usage of the website or online platform, monitoring and analyzing the website or online platform performance. This means we can find out what works and what doesn't, it allows TCP to continuously improve, monitoring and fixing problems quickly. If you opt to disable these cookies, we will not know when you visited our website.

III. FUNCTIONALITY COOKIES

Functionality cookies are used to allow TCP to remember your preferences for helpful features. In summary, functionality cookies keep the user's preferences regarding the use of the website, thus it is not necessary to reconfigure the website each time you visit it. If you opt to disable these cookies, some or all of these features may not work correctly.

IV. ADVERTISING COOKIES

Advertising cookies are set on our website by our advertising partners. When you visit TCP websites or online platforms, some third parties may also use cookies on our website for advertising. This kind of cookies will help in providing users with adverts that appear more likely to be of interest to you, by collecting information about users browsing habits. For information regarding these third-party cookies please check the respective third party's privacy and cookies policy.

Cookies can be set by TCP, or on our behalf, and used on our websites or online platforms, however, TCP also use third party Cookies, which are Cookies set by third parties, used outside or within the environments of our websites or online platforms (Google Analytics and Log Rocket). We have no control over how these Cookies are managed, even when you are directed to other sites through our our websites or online platforms. 4. Control your Cookies settings

Once you have given us your agreement to the use of cookies, we shall store a cookie on your device to remember this for next time. If you wish to withdraw your agreement at any time, you will need to delete our cookies using your internet browser settings. You should do this through the browser settings for each browser you use.

Please be aware that some of our services will not function if your browser does not accept cookies. However, you can allow cookies from specific websites by making them "trusted websites" in your internet browser.
